

Habitat Design


Dwellings are spatial imprinting of human needs for essential activities related to housing. The socio economic stature as well as other criteria's often influence the manner in which housing projects are envisioned. The 3rd semester students explore aspects of community living and relevance of various principles of design in confronting the issue of evolving sustainable dwelling designs.

The studios are headed by professional architects and faculty members. Emphasis is laid on physical visits to housing projects in the region which are done for realization of design and construction issues. Along with building rules and regulations, design briefs are generated.

Visual Appraisal

Architecture is a field which draws the curiosity of the learner beyond limits provoking him to stay focused and build a desire for acquiring more relevant information. Beyond the visual experience lies an untold rhythm, a sense of belonaina and most of all, an architect's innate expression. The overall idea of the first year design studio is to explore architecture and create cognition about its working.

During this initial phase, the faculty members inculcate awareness in the learners regarding various aspects of basic design. Experiential learning enhances the proper molding of various domains of transmission and transaction of learning - cognitive, effective, perceptive and psychomotor realms. Basic understanding of essential concepts is applied in appraisal of built environments in their academic pursuits which stimulates the evolution of design development in the next phase of learning.



An architecture aspirant ages through tedious vet interesting program of study spanning over 5 years, evolving elevated levels of aptitude and attitude for critical thought and action. The key components of the architecture education are interlinked to the basic attribute of conception and realization of built environment. The critical clarity with which an institution approaches to deliver the cohesive whole in design education, dictates the philosophy of the institution.

The academic program takes the candidates through an expedition where learning is not limited to the institutional environment or borders of a continent. The students explore micro/macro level parameters relating to habitat design and planning of cities and towns. They explore environments in detail comprehending the logic behind naturally evolved human settlements, relating it to planned cities and trying to understand the stature of urban agglomeration and associated chaos of unplanned growth - the bench mark being the relevance of Time, Space & People.


Health Care Design


